The Student Affairs staff in the Student Support Center is available for students with physical, intellectual, health, and psychiatric disabilities. Student Affairs counselors are available to discuss various avenues of support and assistance aimed at fostering participation in the musical and educational opportunities at Musicians Institute.

These supports include access to classrooms, services, programs, and events at Musicians Institute. The college complies with [Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act](#) of 1973 and the [Americans with Disabilities Act](#) of 1990.

Students are required to provide documentation of such disability in order to benefit from such programs/options. Students with disabilities are encouraged to meet with Student Affairs counselors to discuss possible options, accommodations and educational plans.

Accommodations and options are provided on an individual, case-by-case basis, specific to the needs and requests of the student with disability.

Accommodations and options at Musicians Institute may include:

- Extended time for exams
- A separate environment for taking exams
- Help with note-taking
- Special seating arrangements
- Additional tutoring hours
- The use of audio recording devices in class
- A reduced course-load*
